

PADUCAH'S CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Program Elements

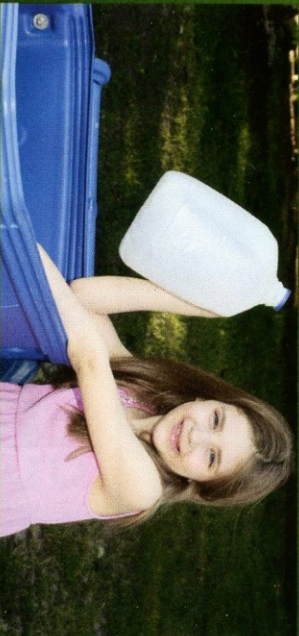
- Residential customers only.
- Voluntary but **MUST** sign up.
- Sign up at any time.
- Single-stream (no sorting necessary). No plastics bags!
- Collection at curbside/roadside (no alleys).
- Uses blue 96-gallon rollout containers.
- Collection twice per month on Mondays

Collection Twice per Month

- If your garbage is collected on Tuesday or Wednesday, recycling will be collected the first and third Monday of the month.
- If your garbage is collected on Thursday or Friday, recycling will be collected the second and fourth Monday of the month.
- Holidays may change collection - see paducahky.gov/city-holidays.

Recycling Drop-Off Facility

The City offers a recycling drop point location at Green for Life (GFL), 400 State Street. Open Monday through Friday (7 - 3:30) and Saturday (8-12). No charge to drop off recyclables!

QUALITY IS KEY

Keeping recyclables clean, dry, and loose in your container - free from contamination - helps ensure materials recycled today have a useful second life.

- My recycling is rinsed, clean, and dry.
- I put food waste in the trash, not with the recyclables.
- My recycling is loose in the rollout and not bagged.

ACCEPTED ITEMS



Office Paper, Newspaper, Junk Mail



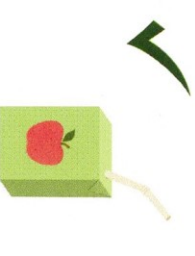
Cardboard and Paperboard (Flattened)



Steel/Aluminum food and Beverage Cans



Plastic Bottles, Jars, Jugs, and Containers (put bottle caps on)



Aseptic Containers (juice boxes, milk cartons, etc.)



Pizza Boxes (remove cheese chunks and pizza crumbs)



DO NOT INCLUDE THESE ITEMS

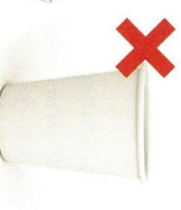
CAUTION! If non-accepted items are mixed with recyclables, the materials could turn the entire load to garbage! Many of these items can tangle in machinery or have processing and market limitations. If you are in doubt, please don't put it in the recycling container.



No Food or Liquids



No Shredded Paper



No Foam Cups and Containers



No Plastic Bags and Plastic Film



No Glass



No Electronics and Batteries



No Household and Medical Hazardous Waste



No Yard Waste



No Clothing, Furniture, and Carpet



No Tires, Metal, and Waste Oil



No Tangling Items (i.e. hoses)



No Non-Recyclable Plastics (i.e. pools)
